

Special Needs Students

Students with a documented IEP or SAP (Student Assistance Plan) are not held to the same level of accountability for foreign language instruction. It is recommended that the student have the opportunity to be exposed to the study of foreign language, if at all possible, based on individual need. The following options are provided:

Audit Class Instruction:

- Student attends classes and participates to his/her level.
- Homework, testing, grading are not required.
- Academic credit is not earned when auditing classes.
- Written documentation is on file regarding this arrangement, signed by the parents.

Exempted from Instruction:

- Student will have no exposure to foreign language program
- Special instructional arrangements will be made for the student, such as:
 - Additional Resource Time
 - Special Studies Skills Program
 - Appropriate Study Hall Session
- Written documentation is on file regarding this arrangement, signed by the parents.
