WHAT IS GABRIEL PROJECT?

- 1. Parish-based help; not a pregnancy resource center
- 2. A confidential pregnancy helpline; not an emergency hotline
- 3. Accompaniment; not case management
- 4. An "Angel" announcing the good news, not only with the mom, but about the ministry's outreach to the whole parish, community and neighborhoods (without any identifying client info)
- 5. Prayers, spiritual support and sharing your faith; not just material support and baby items
- 6. Catholic outreach, not secular, that helps any pregnant woman in need
- Assistance to any pregnant woman in need of a listening ear, encouragement, and connection; not just to abortion-minded unwed teens
- 8. Gift for Life financial assistance; an "Angel" does not give money
- 9. FREE support to you and the mom; the parish does not raise money
- 10. Encounters and relationship, with the mom, plus the resources in your area; vs. waiting for moms to come to Volume Diocese of

GABRIEL PROJECT, PREGNANCY ASSISTANCE

Our ministry offers help with:

- A Helpline, answered by staff, who make a confidential needs assessment
- Referrals for medical, housing, legal or other experts and providers
- Gift for Life charity care to fund prenatal, rent/utilities, counseling, etc.
- Connection to an "Angel" companion for follow-up support in their area
- Developing relationships for a comprehensive network of support



GABRIEL "ANGEL" PRESENCE

Basic level

- Brief weekly calls or video chats
- Check-in with quick texts
- Follow-up on referrals
- Offer to pray for and with her
- Encourage—affirm—validate
- "Listen with the ear of your heart"

Bonus +

- Get together for coffee
- Meet up at Church for Sacraments &/or social
- Blessing of the Womb by priest
- Introduce her to contacts
- Collect baby items



BUILDING A RELATIONSHIP WITH GP MOM

Basic Attachment Needs:

- I. safety and security
- 2. seen, heard, known, and understood
- 3. comforted, soothed, reassured
- 4. valued, treasured, delighted in, and cherished
- 5. support for my highest good

GABRIEL "ANGEL" MATCH STEPS

- Review confidential "Angel" referral form from Gabriel Parish Leader via GP office.
- Schedule a phone call consult within a week with assigned GP staff member:
 - Ask any questions
 - Confirm referral follow-up
 - Check GP parish community resource list
- Make initial contact with the expectant mother within a couple of days:
 - To introduce yourself
 - Establish I-2 times for weekly availability
 - Obtain or verify initial needs
- Use GP4U goal checklist as a basis for developing an individualized development plan.
- Share regular updates to GP parish leader and GP director:
 - Track GP4U items & other activities
 - Record highlights & capture experience
 - Photo of "Angel" and Mom



BABY ITEMS WISH LIST

Standards for financial or material donations:

- Please do not accept cash, or give out to the GP mom
- Please refer donors to <u>arlingtondiocese.org/giftforlife</u>
- Please do not accept gift cards, or give out
- Please ask donors to purchase item needed
- Please only ask for items needed, preferably new material,
 especially items with safety concerns for liability reasons

PARISH COMMUNITY RESOURCE SHEET

Identify & Inventory in your area (for referrals to and from)

- Pregnancy resource centers make GP mom introductions & drop off donations
- County Family Services public government agencies, WIC, car seat program
- Public Schools parent liaisons, nurses & guidance counselors
- Medical health centers, free clinics, urgent care, hospitals, private practices
- Other parish-based outreaches food pantries, emergency assistance, StVdP
- Housing Homeless, transitional and domestic violence shelters
- Other support childcare, parenting and family education
 - Do they serve pregnant women in need, in what ways, and how many?
 - What need is NOT being fulfilled, or are there service gaps?
 - Could any use support, encouragement or a listening ear with referral follow-up?
