What is the Mobile Response Center Vehicle?

Thanks to a partnership with Catholic Charities USA and the Ford Motor Company, Catholic Charities in Arlington will be able to provide curbside assistance to area homeless and poverty-stricken communities for one week each month. The Mobile Response Center Vehicle is a 26-foot retrofitted Ford F550
