ASBESTOS AWARENESS TRAINING INSTRUCTIONS and TEST ***PRINT THIS DOCUMENT***

- Print the Asbestos Awareness Training test (this document), you will need the printed copy at the end of the video presentation.
- Watch the video in its entirety, set aside approximately 2 hours for the training.
- Take the test at the end of the video presentation by marking your answers on the printed test.
 - The test must include your ***printed first and last name***, the ***printed name of school where you work***, and ***the test score***.
- Print the Asbestos Awareness Training form. Complete and sign applicable areas. Be sure to enter the date the training was taken and your name as you wish it for the certificate.

The “Asbestos Awareness Training” document is to acknowledge that you have, watched the video, taken the test, read the required OSHA laws and read your school’s asbestos management plan, specifically the location of “confirmed asbestos” in your school.

If you are operating under “presumed or suspected” asbestos, a signature is still required acknowledging that you know where the presumed or suspected asbestos is located.

If your school does not have asbestos, we will need the letter, from the construction company, advising that no asbestos containing building material was used for the construction of the school.

- Scan test and Asbestos Awareness Training form and email to riskmanagement@arlingtondiocese.org.

Once both the completed test and the Asbestos Awareness form are received by ORM and it is confirmed that you have received a passing score on the test, the Certificate of Completion will be sent electronically.
