

LIFE IS VERY GOOD 2020 **INFORMATION FOR GROUP LEADERS**

MARCH FOR LIFE: The morning event is scheduled with the timing of the March in mind. Our event will end at 11:00am so you can arrive at the mall shortly before noon. The March begins at 1:00pm.

LOCATION:

The event is being held at the EagleBank Arena on the campus of George Mason University. The address is 4500 Patriot Circle, Fairfax, VA. Traffic in the morning is bad; please plan accordingly.

INCLEMENT WEATHER:

Please note that this event will happen regardless of the weather.

REGISTRATION:

To register your group, please print out and complete the form for either or both events and return, with payment, to the address on the form. Seating will be assigned upon receipt of payment. We will confirm via e-mail.

TICKETS:

You will receive your tickets in early January. All participants must present their ticket to enter; lost tickets will not be replaced. There are no refunds.

PARKING:

Because this event is on a college campus, parking is extremely limited. All participants must arrive by bus. If this is a difficulty for you, please contact April at april.hjelstrom@arlingtondiocese.org, so that we are able to estimate the number of expected vehicles.

MEALS:

Dinner: A list of restaurants in the surrounding area will be available on the website. It is highly suggested that you call ahead of time if you have a large group! The concession stand at the venue will be open from 6:30-10:00pm.

Breakfast: The concession stand at the venue will be offering a number of breakfast options. They will be open from 8:00-9:30am.

Lunch: We have arranged a boxed lunch with Chick-fil-A which will be included in the ticket price for the Morning Rally and Mass. The lunches will be distributed immediately after the event and are to be consumed en route to the March.

HOTEL ACCOMMODATIONS:

PRIESTS:
