



REGISTER TO VOTE!

This fall, voters will elect Virginia General Assembly candidates — and in some areas — “down-ballot” offices. The deadline to register is **Monday, Oct. 16**.

✓ Who is eligible to register?

- Must be a U.S. citizen.
- Must be a resident of Virginia.
- Must be 18 on or before the next election (e.g., 17-year-olds born on or before Nov. 7, 2005 can register today).
- Not be registered and plan to vote in another state.

✓ How to register:

You can register online, by mail, or at your local registrar’s office, among other locations. Visit **vote.elections.virginia.gov** or **scan the QR code** to:

- Register to vote online.
- Check registration status.
- Find your polling place.
- Apply to vote absentee by mail.
