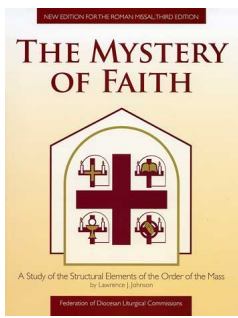

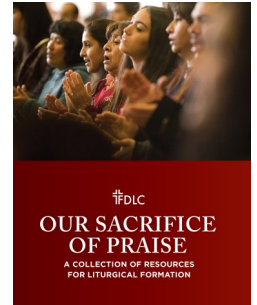


The Mystery of Faith (*English edition*) | **El misterio de fe** (*Spanish edition*)

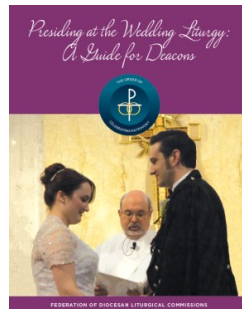
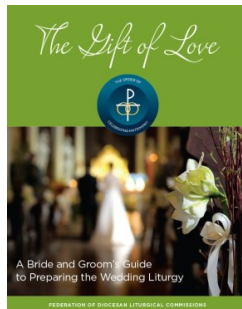
Our Sacrifice of Praise / Nuestro sacrificio de alabanza (*bilingual*)

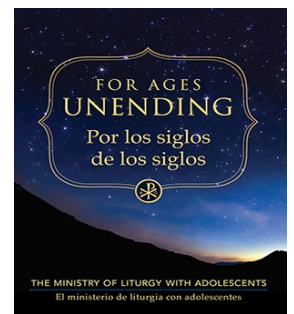
