The Diocese of Arlington Scholarship Foundation (DASF) was created in 2012 to support scholarships for new students from low-income families who wish to attend a diocesan Catholic school. The DASF is part of the Virginia Education Improvement Scholarship Tax Credit Program, and scholarship recipients must meet the financial requirements established by the Commonwealth of Virginia.

Our schools integrate our Faith into every subject as the essential element of a superior Catholic education. This is the Catholic school difference that more than 17,000 students across the Diocese are able to experience, many because of the scholarships made available through this program.

To date, the DASF has helped more than 1,500 students-in-need realize the dream of attending a Catholic school in our diocese. By the grace of God and with the generous support of our DASF donors, the post-COVID surge in enrollment in our schools, more than 1,000 new students, has been sustained. It is worth taking special note of the fact that more than 130 of our graduates have gone on to pursue religious vocations.

Our generous donors expand the educational opportunities for these young people while also receiving the benefit of federal and state tax savings. Qualified donations to the DASF are eligible for a 65% Virginia State tax credit as well as a charitable tax deduction on the remaining 35%. You do not need to itemize on your tax return to qualify for the state tax credit.

Each year the need for funding grows to support new and current students. It is not too late for you to contribute in 2024! Please consider participating. More than \$3 million in scholarships are made possible by generous support of the Diocese of Arlington Scholarship Foundation.

It's not too late to apply to receive your 65% tax credit for 2024! Follow these steps to get your tax credit:

- **1**. Obtain a Preauthorization Request Form. You can either contact our office or download a copy at www.arlingtondiocese.org/Scholarship-Foundation.
- 2. Follow the instructions on the Preauthorization Request Form and email the completed, signed form to DASF@arlingtondiocese.org. Our office will process the request with VA DOE on your behalf and email the approval form to you.
- 3. Once you receive the approval (this form has a 6-character approval code at the top), complete Part 1 of this form, sign it, and mail it with your check to: Diocese of Arlington Scholarship Foundation, 200 North Glebe Road, Suite 811, Arlington, VA 22203.
- 4. Make checks payable to Diocese of Arlington Scholarship Foundation or D.A.S.F. If the donation is stock or marketable securities, contact us for a stock donation form and instructions. Note that charitable distributions from IRAs are accepted, however these may be subject to a limit on the tax credit amount. Please consult your tax advisor for guidance on your own specific circumstance.
- 5. Once your signed approval and donation have been received, the Diocese of Arlington Scholarship Foundation will send the donor an acknowledgment letter for the donation as well as a copy of the Virginia tax credit certificate.
