GOAL SUMMARY

The goal of this session is to help teens see the whole story of salvation history and how Jesus is the fulfillment of Scripture.

In this animated video narrated by Fr. Mike Schmitz, he tells the story of salvation history. He explains from the beginning of creation, through important covenants between God and men, ultimately with Jesus as the final covenant. The video does not just stop with Jesus' death and resurrection, it includes the Church, sacraments, and the fact that Jesus will come again in His Glory to judge the living and the dead.

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- 1. What is your first reaction after watching this video? What is something new you learned?
- 2. What does this salvation history timeline tell you about God?
- 3. God is still working through the 7 sacraments of the Church; how are they a call and invitation to us?
- 4. Through all the Old Testament covenants and prophets, God patiently, slowly, and deliberately revealed Himself and His love to more and more people before Christ came into the world. Why is His moving so slowly significant?
- 5. God would rather die than risk spending eternity without you. How can you live your life in grateful acknowledgement of this sacrifice?
