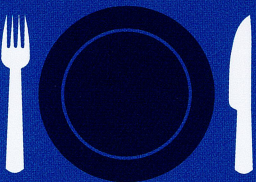

St. Lucy Project Food Insecurity Map

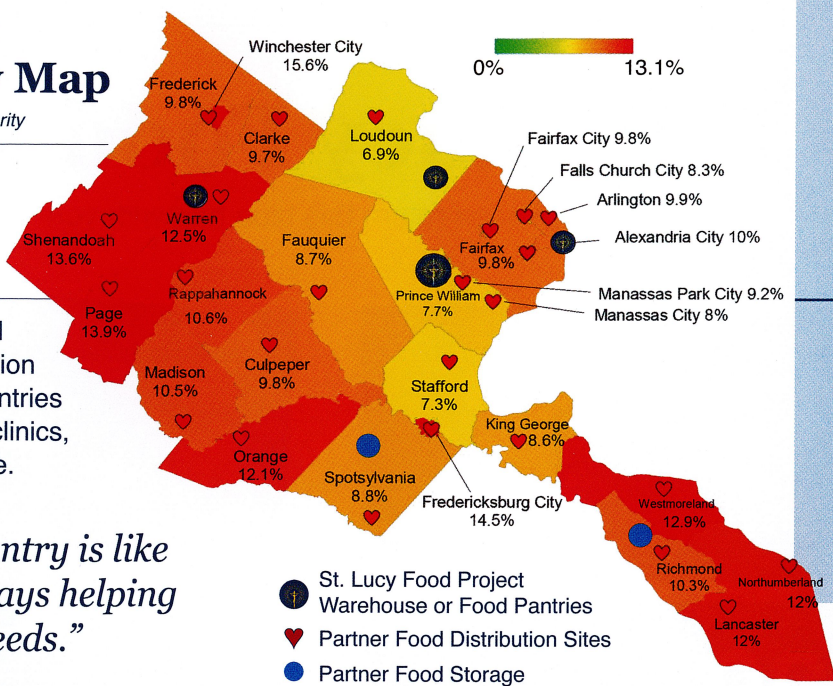
